ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Principia transitioned from quarters to semesters beginning Fall 2011. Principia's unit of credit is the semester hour. The records of students whose enrollment spanned the transition were converted from quarter hours to semester hours. The records of students who were enrolled only before Fall 2011 have not been converted to semester hours and continue to be expressed in quarter hours. In the conversion from quarter hours to semester hours, all hours were divided by 1.5.

The length of the semester is 16 weeks, including 14 weeks of classes, an exam week, and in-term breaks. A semester hour represents three hours of student work per credit per week for 14 weeks. Depending on the method of instruction, the ratio between contact time and student work outside of class varies. No academic credit is given to PE. One PE course is comprised of a minimum of 42 hours of activity (three hours per week for 14 weeks). The length of the quarter was 10 weeks. A quarter hour credit represents 30 hours of academic work. This was generally one hour of contact time and two hours of homework per quarter hour per week. On the quarter calendar, one PE course required 30 hours of activity (three hours per week for 10 weeks).

ACCREDITATION

Principia College is a four-year college of liberal arts and sciences accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA). Illinois State Board of Education has accredited Principia College to certify teachers in programs approved for elementary and secondary education.

CEEB CODE

The CEEB code for Principia College is 1630.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

120 semester hours must be completed with a C average or better (2.000 cumulative GPA). Further requirements for graduation are addressed in the college catalog.

Degrees completed before the conversion to semesters required 180 quarter hours with a C average or better (2.000 GPA), although students with transfer work could graduate with 179 quarter hours.

RANK IN CLASS

Rank in class is not officially computed.

GRADUATION HONORS

Degrees awarded after July 1, 2014: Students maintaining a grade point average of 3.850 and completing the graduation requirements are granted a degree with highest scholastic honors. Students who maintain a grade point average of 3.650 and complete the graduation requirements are granted a degree with scholastic honors.

Degrees awarded prior to July 1, 2014: Students maintaining a grade point average of 3.750 and completing the graduation requirements were granted a degree with highest scholastic honors. Students who maintain a grade point average of 3.500 and complete the graduation requirements were granted a degree with scholastic honors.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Courses passed with a grade of C- or better at another regionally accredited institution may be accepted for credit provided they parallel courses available at Principia. Only grades earned at Principia College are used to compute the student's grade point average.

PHI ALPHA ETA

Phi Alpha Eta is Principia College's honorary scholastic society, open to students who meet the society's GPA, credit, and residency criteria.

DEAN'S LIST AND HONOR ROLL

Beginning Fall 2004, Dean's List and Honor Roll recognition is indicated at the end of each applicable term. Prior to Fall 2004 no notation regarding Dean's List and Honor Roll was made on transcripts.

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
